ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 51

AN ORDINANCE REALLOCATING 909 HOURS OF SICK LEAVE THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY USED IN PLACE OF WORK-CONNECTED INJURY LEAVE HOURS TO KEVIN ERTLEY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Kevin Ertley utilized 909 hours of sick time while recovering from an injury that occurred while he was on duty; and

WHEREAS, the injury was an approved claim by the Bureau of Workers' Compensation and Kevin was released back to full duty after said injury; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2008-128, Kevin Ertley is requesting to recover his lost sick leave benefits now that the Workers' Compensation claim has been approved by the Bureau of Workers' Compensation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to reallocate to Kevin Ertley 909 hours of sick leave that were previously used in place of his work-connected injury leave hours.


SECTION 2. Of the hours allocated by the Finance Director to Kevin Ertley, 909 hours will be used to restore previously expended sick leave benefits for a maximum total of 909 hours of reimbursement.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that it is fair and just to return to said employee sick leave used for work related injuries as soon as possible, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


