

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE PRE-ORDERING OF MANHOLES AND CATCH BASINS FOR THE HOLY FAMILY BY-PASS SEWER PROJECT FROM PROFESSIONAL SERVICES & PREFERRED SOURCE VENDOR MACK INDUSTRIES, WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has requested authorization for an expenditure for pre-ordering of manholes and catch basins for the Holy Family By-Pass Sewer Project from professional services and preferred source vendor Mack Industries, pursuant to C.O.S. Sections 173.07(a)(1)B and 173.07(b)(1)D; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 173.10, C.O.S., the total amount of the expenditure requires legislative approval by this Council;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Forty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$40,000.00) to professional services and preferred source vendor Mack Industries for pre-ordering of manholes and catch basins for the Holy Family By-Pass Sewer Project.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


