

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE LAW DIRECTOR’S APPOINTMENT OF JAIME SYX AS DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF LAW OF THE CITY OF STOW, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR SAID APPOINTEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Law Director desires to appoint Jaime Syx as a full-time permanent Deputy Director of Law of the City of Stow, effective April 29, 2019; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon this Council to confirm this appointment before the same becomes final; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems that the appointee herein does possess the qualities necessary to fulfill the office of Deputy Director of Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The appointment by the Law Director of Jamie Syx as Deputy Director of Law of the City of Stow be, and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council effective as of April 29, 2019.

SECTION 2. That said appointee shall be in the unclassified service of this City and shall perform such duties as are required by the Law Director.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to pay unto said Jamie Syx the sum of \$35.76 per hour, which, along with employee benefits, shall be in accordance with the general payroll ordinance of the City of Stow.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason of ensuring that sufficient Law Department staffing is in place to carry out the responsibilities as assigned by the Law Director and Charter of the City of Stow, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


