AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-128, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE GENERAL PAYROLL ORDINANCE, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 4.05 THEREOF, ENTITLED "UNIFORM ALLOWANCE", TO INCREASE THE UNIFORM ALLOWANCE FOR THE RECORDS SUPERVISOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the non-union position of Records Supervisor has been established and is entitled to a uniform allowance; and

WHEREAS, it is only fair that this position has the same level of compensation for his/her uniform allowance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION</u> 1. That Ordinance No. 2008-128, particularly Section 4.05 thereof, entitled "Uniform Allowance", which formerly read:

"4.05 <u>Uniform Allowance.</u> Each full-time employee required by the City to wear a uniform on a daily basis shall be entitled to the following uniform allowances annually payable on or about June 1 or July 1 of each year or as indicated:

<u>SECTION</u> 2. That the amendment contained herein be effective June 1, 2019 unless otherwise set forth.

SECTION 3. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 2008-128 not amended herein be, and the same are, hereby affirmed as if fully reappearing herein, and that all terms and provisions in conflict with the same be, and the same are, hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that it is fair and just that this amendment for the uniform allowance be effective as soon as possible, and pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval of Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
