

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING LORREE VILLERS AS CLERK OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 4.05, CHARTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 4.05, Charter, provides that Council appoint a person to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of the office of Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this office has become vacant due to the retirement of the present Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to appoint a qualified individual to hold such office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Lorree Villers be, and she hereby is, appointed to the office of Clerk of Council of the City of Stow effective as of June 10, 2019. Said appointee shall be in the unclassified service and shall perform such duties as are delineated in Section 4.05 Charter. This appointment shall be for such term of office or until such time as this Council or a succeeding Council shall otherwise act or until his/her death, resignation or permanent incapacity.

SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to pay unto said Lorree Villers the sum of \$26.52 per hour, which, along with employee benefits, shall be in accordance with the general payroll ordinance of the City of Stow.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in order to ensure that sufficient Council staffing is in-place to carry out the responsibilities as assigned by the Charter of the City of Stow, and pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
