

MINUTES:

CEMETERY BOARD –June 26, 2019

ROLL CALL TAKEN: All members present.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 3:02 p.m.

BURIAL OF CREMAINS:

Tom Fanara said that he would like to add to the Cemetery Rules & Regulations book that all cremains must be brought to the cemetery by a funeral home of the choice of the family. Tom would like to have the check and the permit given to us by the funeral home and not the family. Ashes could be delivered by the funeral home on the morning of the day of burial.

INCREASE OF CEMETERY FEES:

Tom Fanara said today he would like to get fees for sales, and opening and closing revised because the Mayor said we would need to present that to Council along with the topic of purchasing additional land for cemetery expansion. Keith said that for increase of sales fees he would like to stay in the \$700.00 range. Dave Renninger said that he liked \$1,000.00 for non resident sales as our obligation is to the residents of the City of Stow. Fees have not been raised since 2011 and Stow is still very low. After a lot of discussion it was decided to raise the resident sale to \$725.00 and non-resident to \$1,000.00. Urn Garden resident sale would be \$550.00 and non-resident \$700.00. Weekday resident and non- resident casket burial \$625.00. After weekday hours and Saturday resident and non –resident casket burial would be \$875.00. Sunday or holiday casket burials for resident and non-resident would be \$1,225.00. Weekday burial of an urn for resident and non- resident would be \$250.00 per permit. After weekday hours or Saturday urn burial for resident and non-resident would be \$350.00 per permit. Sunday or holiday urn burial for resident and non-resident would be \$500.00 per permit. A motion was made by Dave Renninger and seconded by Keith Redmon and passed unanimously.

RIGHTS OF BURIAL WERE PASSED AND SIGNED.
